



Ice Cream Sandwich-Candy Bar Dessert

Makes about 10 to 12 servings

Prep: 10 minutes, Freeze: 6 hours

2¼ cups heavy whipping cream

½ cup Domino® Confectioners' Sugar

18 ice cream sandwiches

1 cup Homemade Chocolate Sauce, completely cooled (see recipe page 42)

6 (2.07-ounce) chocolate-coated caramel-peanut nougat bars, chopped, Snickers®

Garnish: ½ cup Homemade Chocolate Sauce

1. In a large bowl, combine cream and sugar. Beat at high speed with an electric mixer just until stiff peaks form. In a 13x9-inch freezer-safe dish, arrange 9 ice cream sandwiches, cutting to fit. Spread half of whipped cream over ice cream sandwiches. Drizzle with ½ cup Homemade Chocolate Sauce, and sprinkle with half of chopped candy bars. Repeat layers with remaining ice cream sandwiches, whipped cream, Homemade Chocolate Sauce, and candy bars.

2. Spray a large sheet of aluminum foil with nonstick cooking spray. Place foil, coated side down, over ice cream sandwich mixture; gently seal. Freeze for 6 hours, or until firm. Let stand for 10 minutes before serving. Garnish with ½ cup chocolate sauce, if desired.

Note: Cut with a sharp knife dipped in hot water.
