### **Materials:**

- 8 (6- to 7-foot) bamboo poles
- 4 large pots (10 to 12 inches diameter)
- 4 ferns or other tropical plants
- potting soil
- table for buffet
- 4 cable ties
- twine
- scissors
- ladder
- tab-top curtain panels
- heavy-duty tape

### **How-to:**

1. Place poles in pots. Add plants, and fill in with potting soil to secure poles. Position pots at 4 corners of table.

2. Secure 2 bamboo poles on sides (front to back) with cable ties or twine.
3. If using cable ties, trim, and cover with twine.
4. Lay 2 remaining poles on top of side poles, and secure with twine.
5. Tie tab-top curtains to back pole, adjusting fullness as desired. (We used 2 pair of curtains, with 3 panels on the back pole and 1 over top for canopy.) Lay 1 curtain over back pole, and secure to front pole with tape. Add greenery with twine, if desired.
